

**RENO AQUATIC CLUB'S**  
**"RENO GAMBLE INVITATIONAL"**  
**LONG COURSE MEET**  
**FRIDAY, SATURDAY & SUNDAY JUNE 18, 19, and 20, 2010**  
Corrected meet sheet: Event #26 open to 11 & up swimmers

- SANCTION:** Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No.: **10-046**
- LOCATION:** Idlewild Pool, Idlewild Drive, Reno, NV. **DIRECTIONS TO POOL:** From CA: I-80 to Reno, take Keystone Ave. exit from freeway. Go south on Keystone – stay in far right lane until you reach Riverside Dr. *Do not go on overpass.* Turn right on Riverside, continue about one block and turn left onto Booth Street Bridge, then take a sharp right turn onto Idlewild Drive. The pool is two blocks up on the right.
- COURSE:** Outdoor heated 50 meter pool. There are eight lanes with Keifer lane lines and an electric timing system. The meet will be run in 7 lanes. The eighth lane will be used as warm-up warm-down only, with Marshalls on duty. The minimum water depth in the competition course, as measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 10'0" at the start end and 3'6" at the turn end. All events will start at a depth of 10'0". The competition course has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4).
- TIME:** Meet begins at 8:30 am everyday with warm-up from 7:00 – 8:15 am.
- RULES:** Current USA Swimming (USA-S) and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course. All events are timed finals. ***All swimmers age 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours. Swimmers may compete in four (4) events per day.*** All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA-S membership cards in visible manner. If local conditions warrant it the Meet Referee and the Meet Director may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.
- ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED TO THE FIRST 500 SWIMMERS, or when the meet estimated time line exceeds the Four Hour Rule per Age Group and Gender.***
- DISTANCE** The 1500 Meter Freestyle will be open to all swimmers age 11 and older.
- EVENTS:** All swimmers entered in the 1500 Free must be checked in by 10:00 am on Friday, otherwise they will be considered scratched from the event. **All swimmers in this event must supply timers and counters.** The 1500 Meter Freestyle will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girl/boy. There will be a 15 minute break before the start of the 1500 events.
- RESTRICTIONS:** Smoking and the use of other tobacco products are prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in the spectator seating or standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers during the meet and during warm-up periods. Glass containers, sale and use of alcoholic beverages are prohibited in **all** areas of the meet venue. **NO ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.**
- ELIGIBILITY:** All swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular fee). Swimmers who enter as "pending" or "applied for" must be prepared to present their current card or register before being allowed to check in unless the Meet Director determines that they are validly pending. Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. Meet is open to qualified swimmers of invited USA-S teams. Swimmers 19 years of age and older may participate in Open events but may not receive awards or score points. Disabled swimmers attached or unattached are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy. *Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Time Verification Procedures.*
- CHECK-IN:** The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check-in for all events shall be no more than 30 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event except for the 1500 freestyle. (See "Distance Events" for check-in requirements). Swimmers who do not check in will not be allowed to compete in the event.

## TWO OPTIONS FOR MEET ENTRY

### ENTRIES:

#### Option 1: **Online Meet Entries**

Enter at <http://ome.swimconnection.com/pc/reno20100618> to receive immediate confirmation of acceptance via email. The “billing information” email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. Online entry requires payment by credit card using our secure site. The cost of using Online Meet Entries is \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total entry fees. Please note that the processing fee is separate fee from the entry fees. Online meet entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Fees collected by the use of this system are completely voluntary. Online meet entry is no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be accepted until midnight, Friday June 11, 2010, or until the meet is determined to be full, whichever occurs first.

#### Option 2: **Traditional Postal System Mailed Entries:**

1. Fill out the provided Consolidated Entry Form completely for each swimmer in your family
2. Cut out your entry card(s) and mail to address below.

Entry forms must be completely filled out including best **LONG COURSE** time for each event. ***Entered times must be submitted in METERS.*** Time Conversions from short course yards will no longer be required. Pacific Swimming’s Rules and Regulations specify that when you have achieved a specific class level (for example, “B” or “A”) in an event in one course, you are considered to be qualified at that same level in all courses. Accordingly, you must always enter a time which maintains the class for which you’re qualified in an event. “No time” entries **will be accepted.**

**ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MONDAY JUNE 7, 2010 OR SUBMITTED THROUGH THE ONLINE ENTRY SYSTEM BY MIDNIGHT WEDNESDAY JUNE 9, 2010 OR HAND DELIVERED BY 7:00 P.M. WEDNESDAY, JUNE 9, 2010. TO: 12080 THOMAS CREEK ROAD, RENO, NV. 89511. Please note that No late entries will be accepted and no refunds will be made. Due to the fact we have point awards, no switching of events and no deck entries will be allowed.**

High point scoring will be scored to the 16<sup>th</sup> place as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>—20, 17,16,15,14,13,12,11. 9<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>—9, 7,6,5,4,3,2,1.
