<u>NOTICE</u>: By entering this meet, the athlete or his/her guardian consents to the publication, via electronic, print or other media, information and/or imagery related to their participation at this meet. Such information and imagery may include, but is not limited to, photographs, psych sheets and live meet results. By entering this meet, the athlete or his/her guardian consents to this publication.

<u>USE OF AUDIO AND VIDEO</u>: Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone camera, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

LOCATION: Dougherty Valley Aquatic Center, 10550 Albion Rd., San Ramon, CA, 94583

Located next to Dougherty Valley High School. From 680, take Bollinger Canyon exit and continue East. Dougherty Valley High School will be on the left. Turn left onto Albion Rd. NO CAMPING ON POOL DECK. ALL equipment must be set up outside pool gates and must be removed at the close of each day.

<u>COURSE</u>: Outdoor, heated 50 meter pool, up to 7 lanes. Separate warm up lanes available. The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 4 feet at the start end and the turn end. The competition course has been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4). The copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming.

TIME: Meet begins at 9:00 AM each day, warm-ups from 7:30 AM to 8:45 AM each day. A special warm-up time for 8 and under swimmers only will be held from 8:45 AM -8:55 AM

<u>RULES</u>: Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course. All events are timed finals. <u>Swimmers may compete in 4 events per day</u>. All swimmers ages 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours. Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated time line, per the "Four-Hour Rule," based on the swimmers age and gender. If local conditions warrant it the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director, may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.

All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner.

UNACCOMPANIED SWIMMERS: Any USAS athlete-member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming member-coach for the purposes of athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a coach-member of the athlete's USAS Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA Swimming member-coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the athlete's USAS Club Member-Coach. The swimmer must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RESTRICTIONS: Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator seating, on standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers, during the meet and during warm-up periods. Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in

<u>all</u> areas of the meet venue. All shelters must be properly secured. No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue. No propane heater is permitted except for snack bar/meet operations.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. Swimmers in the "A" Division must have met at least the listed "PC-A" time standard. Swimmers in the "B" Division must have met at least the listed "PC-B" time standard. All entry times slower than the listed "PC-B" time standard will be in the "C" Division. Entries with **"NO TIME"** <u>will not be</u> accepted and refunds will not be given. Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures. Disabled swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy. Swimmers 19 years of age and over may compete in the meet for time only, no awards. Such swimmers must have met the time standards for the 17-18 age groups. The swimmer's age will be the age of the swimmer on the first day of the meet.

ENTRY PRIORITY: Zone 2 entries from teams assigned to the venue postmarked or entered online by 11:59 p.m. on **Monday, May 21, 2012** will be given priority acceptance. All entries from Zone 2, all other Pacific LSC Zones and other LSCs, either postmarked, entered online, or hand delivered by the entry deadline will be considered in the order that they were received and accepted until the meet reaches its capacity.

ENTRY FEES: \$2.75 per event, \$10.00 participation fee per swimmer. Entries will be rejected if payment is not sent at time of request.

MAILED OR HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES: Entries must be on the attached consolidated entry form. Forms must be filled out completely and printed clearly with swimmers best long course time. Entries must be entered using the current Pacific Swimming. Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday, May 28, 2012 or hand delivered to the address above by 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 30, 2012. No late entries will be accepted. No refunds will be made, except mandatory scratch downs. Requests for confirmation of receipt of entries should include a self-addressed envelope.

<u>ONLINE ENTRIES</u>: You may enter this meet online or by U.S. mail. To enter on-line go to <u>http://ome.swimconnection.com/pc/SRVL20120609</u> to receive an immediate entry confirmation this method requires payment by credit card. Swim Connection LLC charges a processing fee for this service, equal to \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total Entry Fees. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees. If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering online is a convenience, is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be accepted through Wednesday, May 30, 2012 or until the meet reaches its capacity.

<u>CHECK-IN</u>: The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check for all events shall be no more than 60 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. No event shall be closed more than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the session. Swimmers who do not check-in will not be allowed to compete in the event.

SCRATCHES: Swimmers entered in an individual event that have checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless they notify the clerk of the course before seeding for that event has begun. Failure to swim an event will result in being barred from their next individual event on that day or the next meet day, whichever is first. Exception: No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if the referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof, or it is determined by the referee that the No-Show is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

<u>AWARDS</u>: Ribbons 1st – 8th place for PC-A, PC-B & PC-C divisions. 6&UN swimmers will swim in 8&UN events but will be awarded separately (1st-8th place, one class of awards only). 13-18 swimmers will be awarded as 13-14 and 15-18 age groups. All "PC-C" and "PC-B" swimmers achieving a "PC-A" time will be awarded a standard "PC-A" medal, regardless of place achieved in the event

ADMISSION: Free. A program will be available for \$5.00.

REFRESHMENTS: A snack bar will be available serving breakfast, lunch, snack and drink items. Coaches and working deck officials will be provided lunch. Hospitality will serve refreshments to timers and volunteers.

<u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>: No overnight parking is allowed. Facilities will not be provided after meet hours. NO camping on deck. All pop-ups and swimmer/participant/spectator equipment must be set up OUTSIDE the pool gates. No overnight security. All items must be removed at the end of the meet on each day.

MINIMUM OFFICIALS RULE: One-half hour before the scheduled start of each session, the Meet Referee shall conduct an inventory of Officials, and shall compare the number of entries against the number of Officials present representing each team. Those teams who have not provided sufficient Officials will be fined \$100 per missing official.

Each team shall, by the start of the meet, provide to the Meet Director or designee a list of Officials who have agreed to represent that team during the meet in accordance with the following table:
